



Bethel Service Scholarship

The Bethel Service Scholarship is a community service scholarship. The amount of the scholarship is at the discretion of the Financial Aid Director. This scholarship only combines with the following Bethel funded scholarships: Contiguous County Grant, Cumberland Presbyterian Grant, and Academic Honor Scholarships (Honors Program excluded). Bethel University reserves the right to limit institutional financial aid to the cost of tuition, double room, meals, and fees when combining institutional aid with any federal and state aid. If the student's living status changes (e.g. from on-campus to off-campus), the scholarship amount will be adjusted accordingly.

The Scholarship recipient must perform at least twenty (20) hours of community service under the direction of the program director each term. Additional community service hours may be required. Failure to complete the required hours will result in loss of the scholarship the following term.

FAILURE TO DO SO WILL CAUSE YOU TO BE INELIGIBLE FOR THIS SCHOLARSHIP IN THE FUTURE.**

Please keep in mind that the locations where you will be volunteering will have certain rules and guidelines that must be met, including dress code, cell phone usage, and attitude. You will be expected to follow these rules and treat these hours of work the same as you would for any other job you might hold.

Please have access to a vehicle. None of the service work can be done from the university and only one location is close enough to walk.
